- 3. A CV of no more than 3 pages. A valid email address is required. We prefer that applications and CVs be submitted by email.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Generally speaking, we expect to make hiring decisions in late March or early April for all Winter or Fall and Spring courses; and in December or January for Summer courses. However, some decisions may be made earlier or later than these time frames, depending on circumstances. Unexpected vacancies may arise at any time. Applications will be retained for twelve (12) months. Persons who submit applications and CVs will receive emailed job postings for specific positions for the subsequent twelve (12) months.
