## Description of Roles

The table below outlines the roles we are seeking volunteers for, along with the training required/recommended for each position and an estimate of the hours required for such training. On the day of the event, we hope that each volunteer will be able to help for at least 2 hours, though they are certainly welcomed to stay for the whole event.

Clean and Set- up Crew	-Standard duties.	-N/A

- The finals and semi-finals will be referred by head judges to ensure consistency in assessment throughout the event.
- The training session for judges will take place in the last week of Feb, or first week of March before the event. We will go over the rules as they pertain to judges. The aim is to ensure that everyone will grade teams using the criteria that characterize the Ethics Bowl.
- It is possible to serve in more than one role, and we will try to ensure that no volunteer serves as just moderator (unless they so prefer).
- Volunteers must arrive early for a mini-orientation session.
