All Teaching Assistants should be prepared to travel to the campus where the course to which they have been assigned is offered **on a weekly basis or more frequently as required**.
- 4 While applicants may state their preferences for specific courses listed on the Department's job posting, the Department reserves the right to assign TAs to whatever courses it feels best suit the candidate's qualifications and departmental needs. TAs will only be assigned to courses in fields in which they are or should be qualified to assist. The Department cannot guarantee that TA assignments will be split evenly over the two academic terms. TA assignments may be confined to or concentrated in a single semester.
